

## MERRY KICKS-MAS!

If you already have my “Just Kickin’ It” pattern, this free inspiration sheet is for you!

You won’t find detailed instructions here - just a way to make the most of a pattern you already own or can get from your local quilt store or at [www.glendawilderdesigns.com](http://www.glendawilderdesigns.com).

To make this holiday table topper:

- 1) Press a 40” square of background fabric to create both horizontal and vertical center lines.
- 2) Mark a 36” circle using your favorite tool or template.
- 3) Using fusible web and mix & match holiday fabrics, make 14) FRONTS of “Just Kickin’ It” boots using the templates from the pattern.
- 4) Place the boot motifs approximately 4” above circle marking, heat set and machine applique. (I like a blanket stitch and use coffee filters as stabilizer!)
- 5) Using Microsoft Word/Word Art feature, create the letters for “MERRY CHRISTMAS” and invert 180 degrees before printing to avoid them coming out backwards (ask me how I know!) Use a size and font you like. I prefer simple, easy to cut shapes. Also Download or draw a simple 5-pointed star in 3” size to create the center ring. Heat set letters and stars and machine applique.
- 6) Quilt your project, then trim and bind! I love circles, but you could make this square or rectangular as a wall hanging, lap quilt of crib quilt, too!

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**BEFORE CUTTING**, remeasure your circle markings as they may become a little distorted during quilting. Once satisfied that you are “in the round” cut the circle shape with scissors.

For circular quilts, be sure to use bias binding! You can download easy directions for making 4 yards of continual bias bindings (with just 2 seams) at [www.glendawilderdesigns.com](http://www.glendawilderdesigns.com).
