Conversion to Fat Quarters



Breezeway was designed and published with instructions for yardage only, but you can easily convert it to a fun fat-quarter, stash busting pattern. Just select the following numbers of FQs to replace the original yardage requirements:

REPLACE	# OF FAT QUARTERS
Lavender (Hoffman 1895-564-Tupelo)	3
Dark Violet (Hoffman 1895-565-Savannah)	3
Green (Hoffman 1895-321-Gecko)	5
White (Hoffman 1377-3-White)	13

Cutting

Cut the indicated numbers of pieces using your Breezeway pattern as a reference for size/specifics:

Assumes all FQs are a full 18" x 22"

Instructional Overview

In general, make 2x the number of strip sets indicated in each step of the instruction. The exception is for making L Units and M Units. You should be able to cut the required number of Units from 1.5x the number indicated in the pattern.

All other pieces and assembly instructions are consistent with the pattern instructions.
